

Application Manual (ChPE Program)

Application and document submission:

1. To complete the application process, all applicants must:

- Fill out the application form at <http://intranet.chem.eng.chula.ac.th/chpe>
- Scan and upload PDF files of certified copies of required documents to <http://intranet.chem.eng.chula.ac.th/chpe>
- Check and confirm your information by clicking “save” on the form
- Transfer a non-refundable application fee of 1,000 bahts (one thousand bahts) to KASIKORNBANK (K-Bank), Chamchuri Square Branch, Account Number: 113-1-48590-1, Account Name: Department of Chemical Engineering (International Program)
- Upload receipt of application fee to <http://intranet.chem.eng.chula.ac.th/chpe>

***Applicants are responsible for verifying that they meet all requirements according to the announcement and that all the provided information is truthful and correct. If there is any mistake made by applicant or the application packet does not meet the requirements, applicant will be disqualified.

- For students who graduated from international schools in Thailand or overseas (whose GPA (grade point average) is not on 4.0 scale), it is required to submit the documents as follows:
 - A certified copy of the High School Equivalency Certificate issued by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand's (CUPT) (in PDF) (Learn more at <https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th/>)
 - A converted grade based on the 4.0-scale GPA (Please convert your GPA before submitting) (in PDF)

1. English

Applicant can submit at least one of the English scores as follows:

TOEFL	not lower than 80
IELTS	not lower than 6.0
CU-TEP	not lower than 80
Duolingo English Test	not lower than 105
Gaokao English	not lower than 100

- 1) For TOEFL/IELTS, please submit a copy of official score report.
- 2) For CU-TEP, please download your score report from the website: <https://atc.chula.ac.th/> and submit it to our system.
- 3) For Duolingo English Test, please download your score report from Duolingo website and submit it to our system.

Applicant who choose to submit **Duolingo English Test** to ChPE program must also send the score to ChPE program via the website within the application period.

In case that applicant has not sent the score to ChPE program yet, applicant must write their **log-in username** and **password** they use to access Duolingo website on the score report for verification purpose.

2. Mathematics

Applicant can submit at least one of the Mathematics scores as follows:

1) For CU-AAT, please download your score report from the website: <https://atc.chula.ac.th/> and submit it to our system.

2) For A LEVEL (Mathematics or Pure Mathematics or Further Mathematics) and IB Mathematics (Applications and Interpretations or Analysis and Approaches HL), please submit a copy of official score report.

Note: Predicted scores/grades are NOT accepted.

3) For SAT Mathematics section and AP Calculus AB, please download your score report from the website: <https://www.collegeboard.org/> and submit it to our system.

Applicant must also send official score report to ChPE program using the college code 9187 (Chulalongkorn University – Chemical Engineering) within the application period.

In case that applicant has not sent SAT/AP score to ChPE program yet, applicant must write their log-in username and password they use to access Collegeboard website on the score report for verification purpose.

4) For ACT Math, please export or take a screenshot of your score report from the website: <https://my.act.org/> and submit it to our system.

Applicant must also send official score report using the code 3033 (Chulalongkorn University) within the application period.

In case that applicant has not sent ACT score yet, applicant must write their log-in username and password they use to access <https://my.act.org/> on the score report for verification purpose.

5) For Gaokao Mathematics, please submit official score report to our system.

3. Science (Physics and Chemistry)

Applicant can submit at least one of the Science scores as follows:

CU-ATS (Physics and Chemistry) not lower than 800 (both parts combined)

A Level Physics and Chemistry not lower than B (each)

AP Physics 1 or AP Physics 2 not lower than 3 (each)

or C-Mechanics and AP Chemistry

ACT Science not lower than 25

IB Physics HL and Chemistry HL not lower than 6 (each)

Gaokao Physics and Chemistry not lower than 60% (each)

***Note:** Test results of Physics and Chemistry part in CU-ATS from different attempts can be submitted separately.*

1) For CU-ATS, please download your score report from the website: <https://atc.chula.ac.th/> and submit it to our system.

2) For A Level Physics and Chemistry and IB Physics HL and Chemistry HL, please submit a copy of official score report.

***Note:** Predicted scores/grades are NOT accepted.*

3) For AP Physics 1 or AP Physics 2, please download your score report from the website: <https://www.collegeboard.org/> and submit it to our system.

Applicant should also send official score report to ChPE program using the college code 9187 (Chulalongkorn University - Chemical Engineering) within the application period.

In case that applicant has not sent **AP** score to ChPE program yet, applicant must write their **log-in username** and **password** they use to access Collegeboard website on the score report for verification purpose.

- 4) For **ACT Science**, please export or take a screenshot of your score report from the website: <https://my.act.org/> and submit it to our system.

Applicant must also send official score report using **the code 3033** (Chulalongkorn University) within the application period.

In case that applicant has not sent **ACT** score yet, applicant must write their **log-in username** and **password** they use to access <https://my.act.org/> on the score report for verification purpose.

- 5) For **Gaokao Physics and Chemistry**, please submit official score report to our system.

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



How Did I Score Compared to Others?


